


Christingle Service

We are sorry for when we make the Christmas season more about us than about you. And for the times when we think, act or speak as if the story of Jesus' birth, and his love for us, is more about making ourselves feel good, than following you in loving others. Father forgive us, and remind us through the Christingle symbol of your greatest gift to us in Jesus, and the example he is to us. **Amen.**

As we offer our prayers to God let us say together the prayer Jesus taught us:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory for ever and ever. Amen. Blessing and Dismissal


St Mary's Choristers is a mixed choir for children aged 7+, based at the beautiful St Mary's Church, Kidlington
