Key Points from PCC Meeting, July 28th 2026

- A Faculty has been granted from the Diocese for Martin's Garden. The committee has been working very hard over many months to get to this point. We hope that construction work can begin in September, using local firm Ace Training, which supports young people starting out in the construction industry.
- Thanks to our recent Stewardship campaign, and the generosity of parishioners, we are in a much more secure financial position than a couple of years ago. Look out for pie charts in the three churches, which give an idea of where all the money goes.
- One huge area of expenditure is on maintenance of our buildings, making them safe and welcoming places in which to worship. Repair of the plasterwork in St Mary's Kidlington will begin very soon.
- Members of the Oxford Deanery were impressed by a recent talk on "Vocational Pathways", a Learning Hub which provides free courses for anyone interested in deepening their faith. Find details at Learning Hub - Diocese of Oxford
- Our Safeguarding Officer, Yo Davies, continues to work very hard to ensure that all events that take place in our buildings, both Church and Non Church activities, comply with the Diocesan requirements for a safe environment.
- Our children and young people's groups continue to grow and flourish. Go4th, the monthly house group, and St Mary's Junior Choir are new this year, and the young people have been busy fundraising for their activity weekend away in September.
